The "Made in Dubai" concept can very well be established worldwide with the efforts of Dubai Design Council.

Dubai Design Council has categorized the membership process according to the level of experiences of jewellery designers as under:

**Category A:** This category is for members who are established professionals who either have their own license or render services to larger organizations in the Industry.

**Category B:** This category is for starters who have little bit of an experience in the field of jewellery along with a good educational background and would want to further expand in the sector.

**Category C:** This category is for generally people / students who have a passion for jewellery designing but lack formal education. Dubai Design Council counsels such candidates and gives an opinion on the Industry and the opportunities that would be presented to them post education.

Each of these three categories have different levels of benefits and support. The membership fee also varies according to categories. Dubai Design Council also plans to provide Digital Platforms, Educational Mining trips, Manufacturing support and more to the members that I do feel will go a long way in enhancing their respective careers in the Industry.
